## **Rebranding of the Parents Committee**

This year, we rebranded the EMSB Parents Committee, formerly the Central Parents Committee (CPC), by changing our name, and commissioning a new logo. Our goal was to promote the ideals of a progressive inclusive community and take into account the new structure of the EMSBPC.

### Parent Conference 2018 (May 5th, 2018)

The EMSB Parents Committee's 2nd annual Parent Conference was a big success. We almost tripled our attendance from last year, attracting about 300 parents. A collaborative effort between the EMSBPC the EMSB administration, and the Council of Commissioners, the Parent Conference offered three workshop sessions on a wide variety of topics from managing stress to bullying to homework to dealing with the new marijuana laws.
