






What is AEVS?

Certification

Varies according to program:

- DVS varies from 6 months to 18 months
- AVS varies from 3 months to 8 months



Admission Requirements

Have a Secondary School Diploma

OR

Be at least 16 years of age and have Secondary IV credits in English, French & Math (or equivalent)

OR

Be at least 18 years of age and successfully complete the GDT (General Development Test)* or SSET (Secondary School Equivalency Test (TENS)

* SPR (Specific Program Requirements)




Recognition of Acquired Competencies

The recognition of acquired competencies (RAC) is a process that allows an individual with skills gained through life or work experience to obtain official recognition of their competencies in relation to a program of study.




The RAC Process










Quebec's Education System Learning Paths (Youth & Adult Sectors)




